4.1 Description of first aid measures

General advice

If inhaled

The following applies to soluble silver compounds: only slightly absorbed via the gastrointestinal tract. Strong irritations after contact with eyes and skin.

Irritation and corrosion, Cough, Shortness of breath, Dizziness, Diarrhoea, gastric spasms, Vomiting, Unconsciousness, death
