

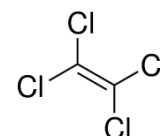

DANGER

Disposal: Allow to evaporate in safe open area (applicable for small quantities). Follow the instructions as per code no. 7, but transfer the waste to drum specifically designated for halogenated hydrocarbon solvents.
