If exposed or concerned: Get medical attention advice. In case of fire, use foam for extinction. If on skin or hair: remove/take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse with water/shower. Remove/Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. IF ON SKIN: Gently wash with plenty of soap and water. Wash/Decontaminate removed clothing before reuse.
