Application: Recommended for selective enrichment of *Listeria* species from food samples.

Composition**

Per vial sufficient for 1000ml of medium

Ingredients	Concentration
Antibiotic mix	50 mg

Directions

Rehydrate the contents of one vial aseptically with 10 ml of sterile distilled water. Mix well and aseptically add to 1000 ml sterile, molten, cooled (45-50°C) MiFast™ Listeria Enrichment Broth Base (DM3048). Mix well and dispense in sterile tubes or flasks as desired.

Specimen Collection and Handling

For food samples follow appropriate techniques for handling specimens as per established guidelines (1). After use, contaminated materials must be sterilized by autoclaving before discarding.

Store at 2 - 8°C. Use before expiry date on the label.
