Response: Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Keep container tightly closed. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. If on skin or hair: remove/take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse with water/shower. In case of fire, use alcohol-type foam for extinction. IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. IF IN EYES:Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. In case of fire, use dry agent for extinction. Specific treatment: refer to Label or MSDS. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Absorb spillage to prevent material damage.

Disposal: Add in small quantities to large, stirred excess of water, keeping the final concentration less than 2%. Neutralize with 5% sodium hydroxide soln. and

run to waste with large quantities of running water.
