

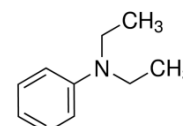

Take victim immediately to hospital. Consult a physician. In case of eyes contact Flush eyes with water as a precaution. If swallowed: Do NOT induce vomiting. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Rinse mouth with water. Consult a physician.
